

Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - There are 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
